Installing

Accessories > Terminal

- sudo add-apt-repository ppa:doctormo/groundcontrol
- sudo apt-get update
- sudo apt-get install groundcontrol
- killall nautilus

Go to your home folder: Places > Home



Using Ground Control

- 1. Install Ground Control
- 2. Restart Nautilus
- 3. Create Projects directory if it hasn't already been created
- 4. Find the project
- 5. Branch the main branch as the owner
- 6. Use Make Show and Make Clean buttons
- 7. Use Update button to pull latest revision
- 8. Make changes, commit, then upload changes

Ground Control Developer buttons

- Stored in the branch
- .gcfunctions file
- Runs commands
- Commands used: make show and make clean
- make show compiles PDF, opens evince with pdf
- make clean removes unnecessary compile-time files
- Run make clean before pushing/uploading your changes
